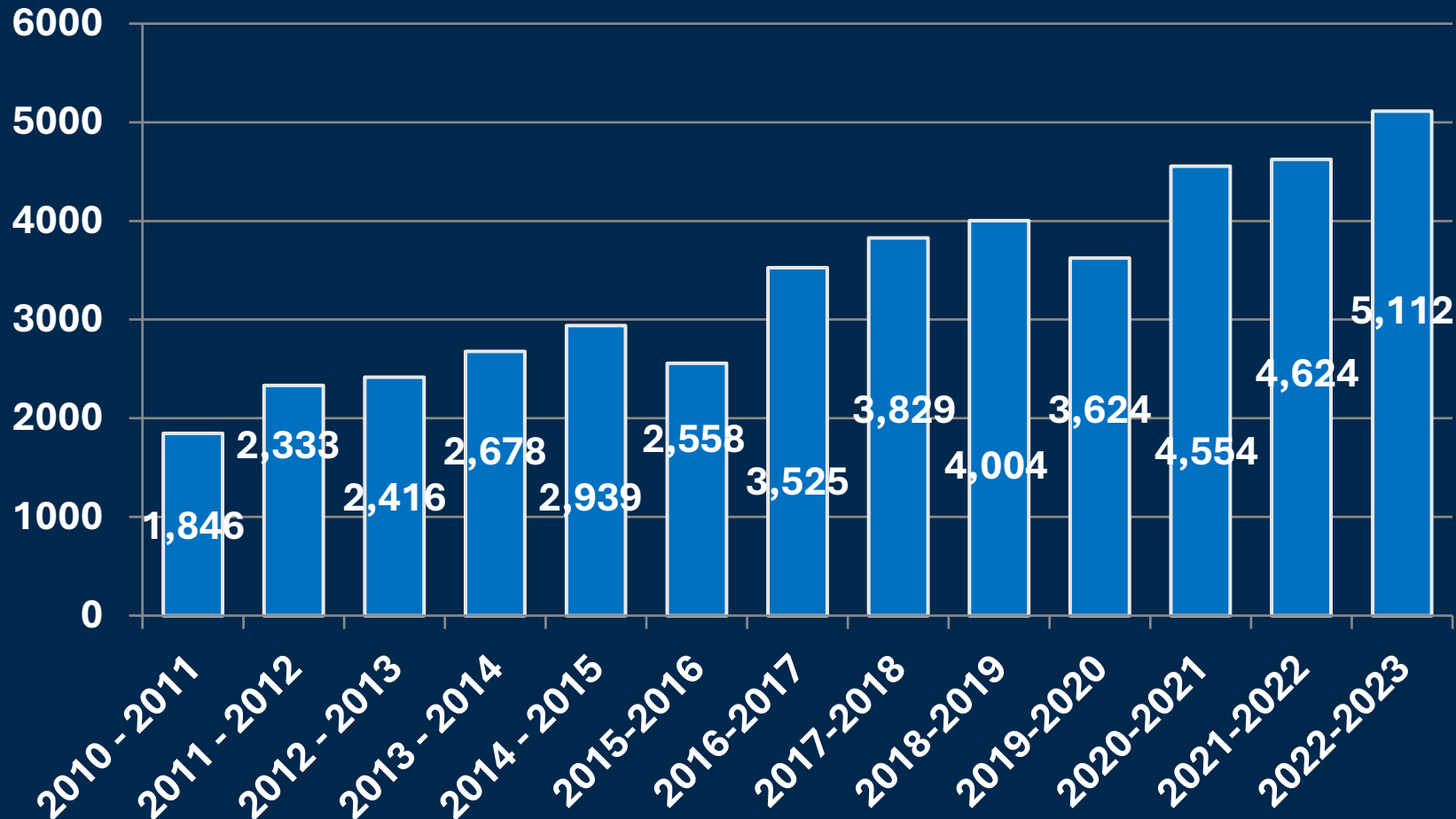


# Annual Cataract Surgeries

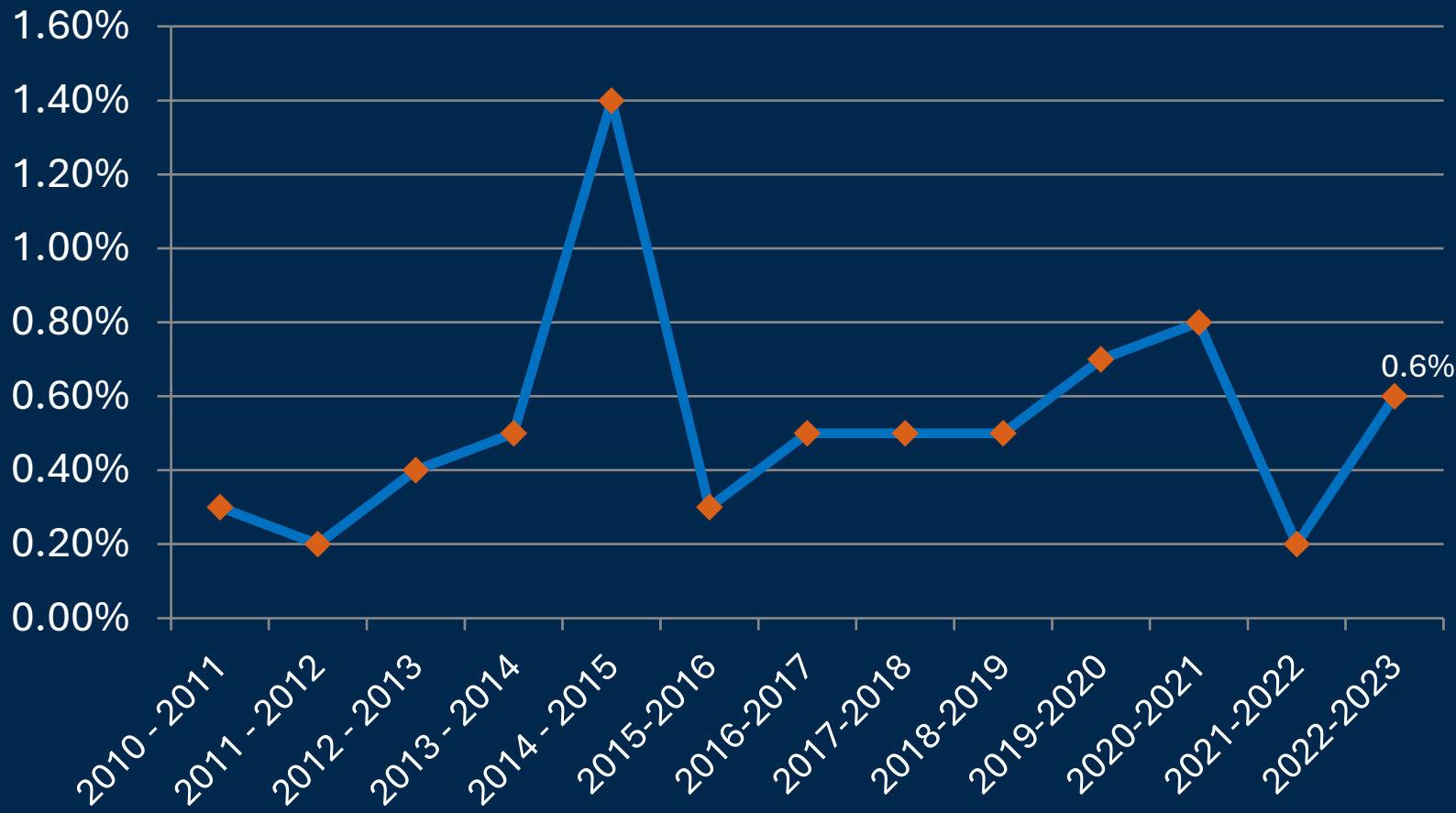


- Kellogg Eye Center ranks among national leaders\* in yearly cataract surgery volume.

- Average per surgeon: 159
- Range: 1 – 767

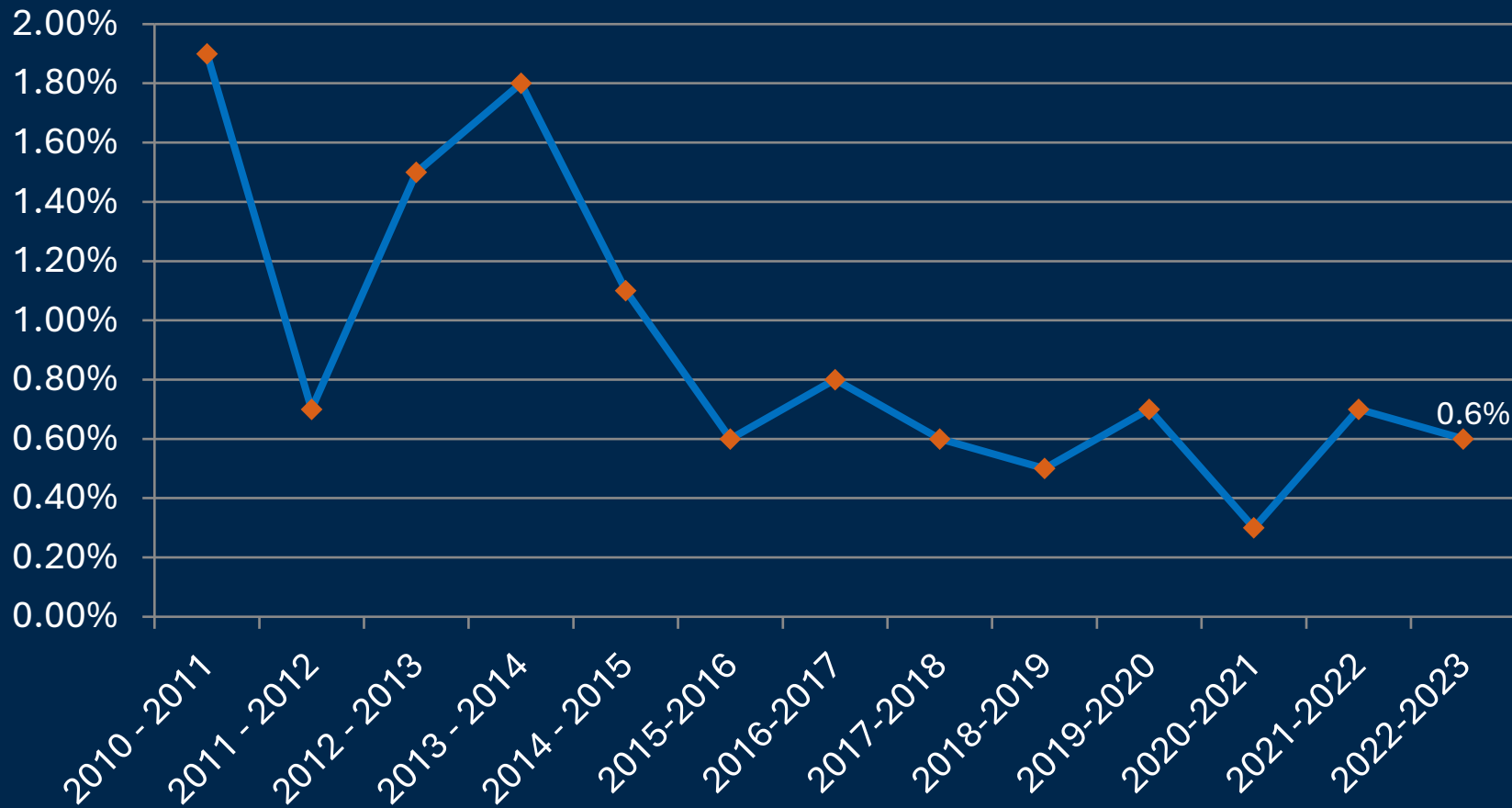

# Reoperation rate within 30 days after cataract surgery



- Needing a second surgery after cataract surgery can indicate there was a complication.
- Less than 1% of cataract surgeries at Kellogg Eye Center require a second surgery within 30 days.
- Range: 0 – 3.8%

# Rate of unplanned anterior vitrectomy



- Sometimes during cataract surgery, damage to nearby structures in the eye can occur. When this happens, it can require a more complex surgery to fix the damage, called an “anterior vitrectomy.”
- Cataract surgeries at Kellogg Eye Center have this complication less than 1% of the time.
- Range: 0 – 3.8%
