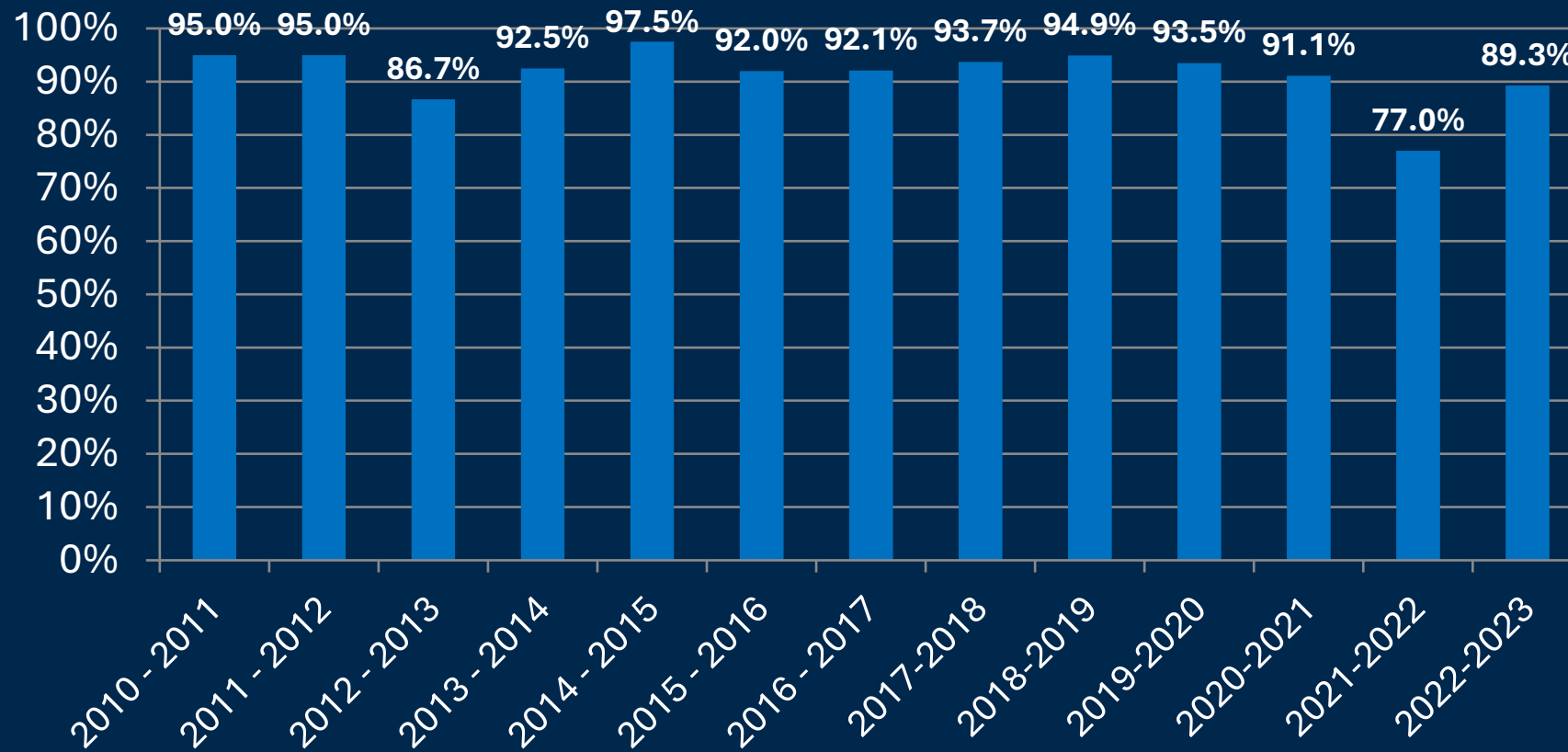
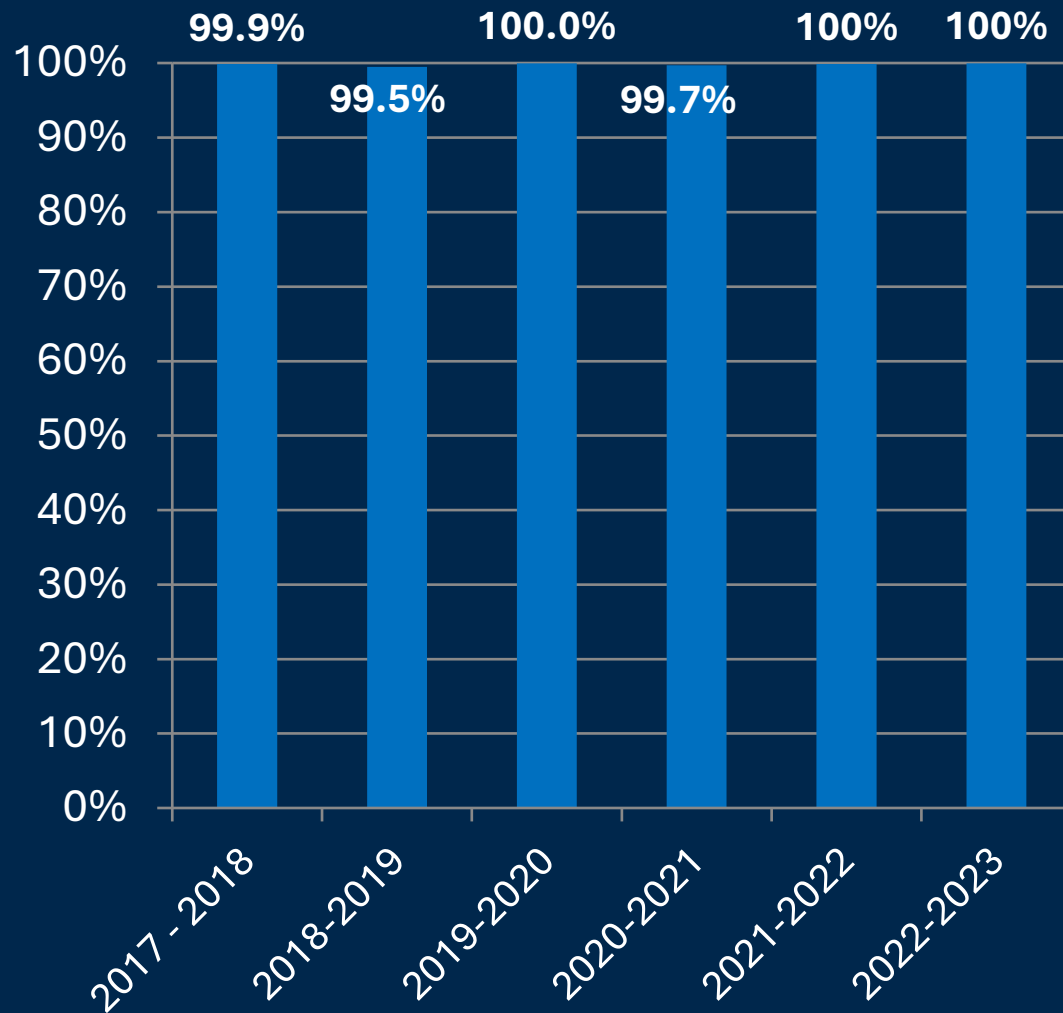


Corneal transplants: Clear transplants at 6 months



- Due to disease or trauma, patients may need to have a transplant of the clear “window” in the front of the eye called the cornea.
- An important measure of success in this surgery is whether the transplanted cornea remains clear.
- The vast majority of corneal transplants at Kellogg Eye Center are clear at 6 months after surgery.
