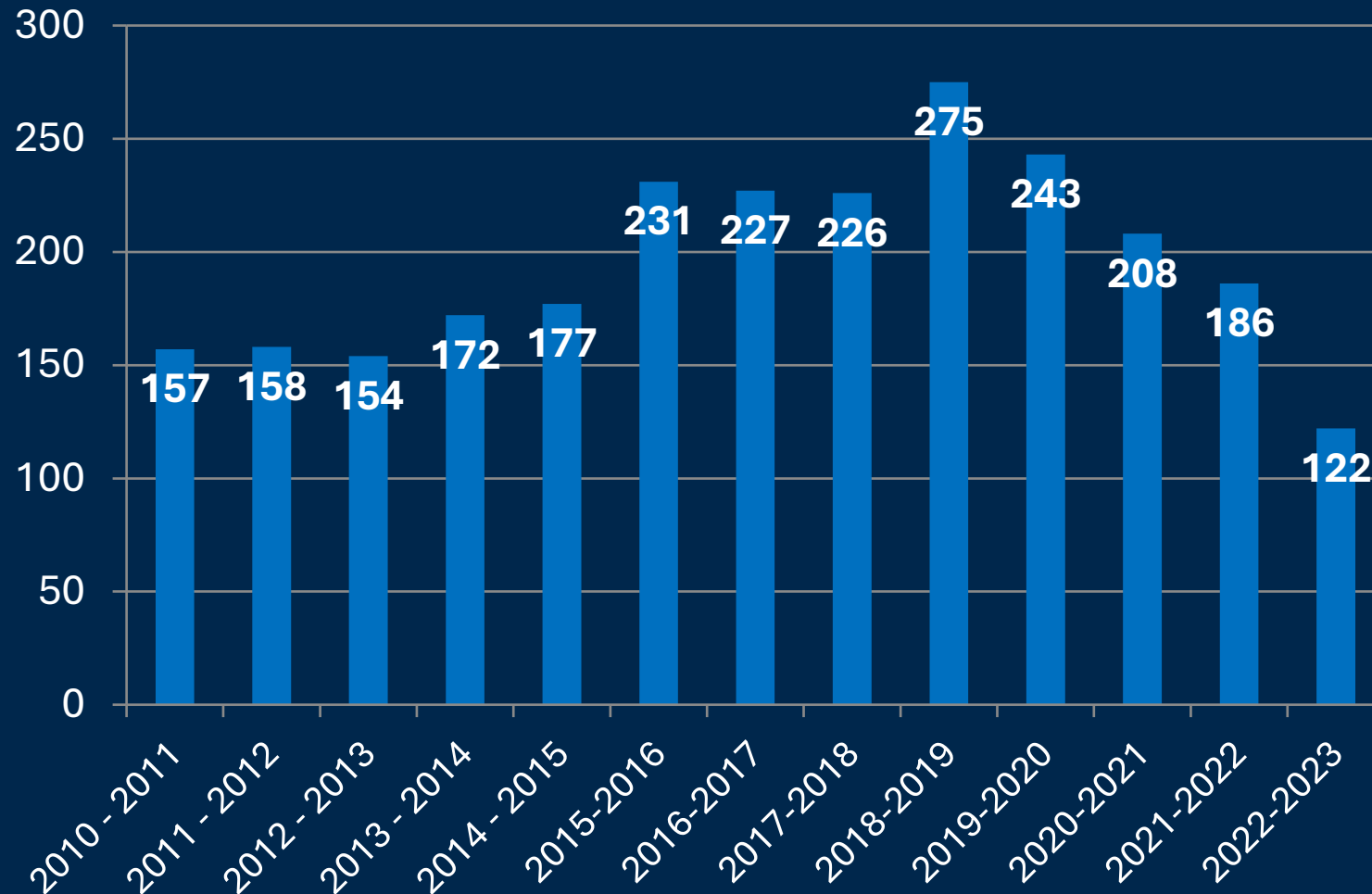
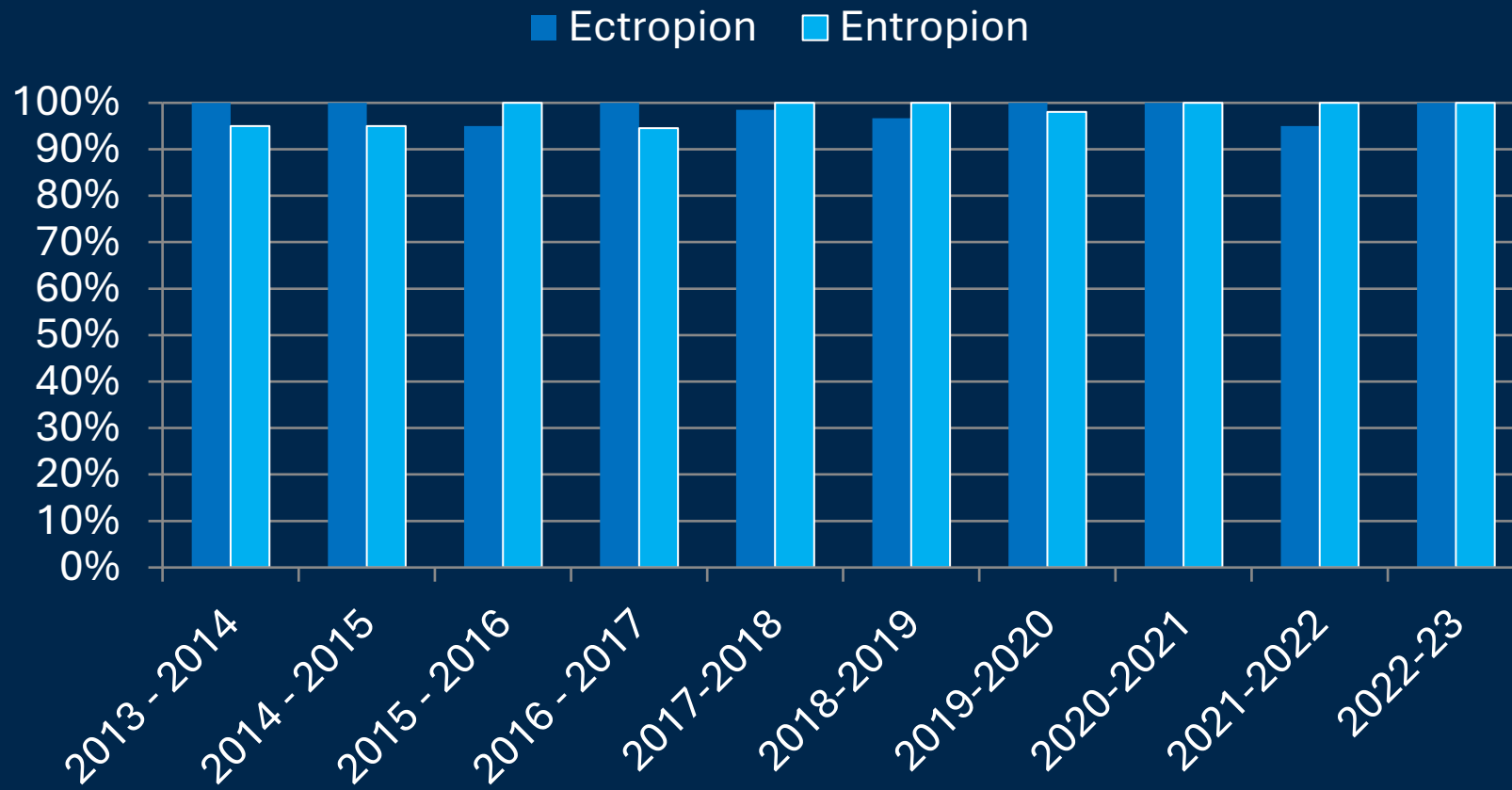


Number of ptosis repairs



- Among many types of eyelid and orbit surgeries, our oculoplastic surgeons fix drooping eyelids, called a “ptosis repair.”
- Kellogg Eye Center surgeons perform hundreds of these surgeries a year.
- The need for a second surgery within 6 months can indicate that the first surgery did not accomplish the goal of lifting the lid. Less than 1 in 140 ptosis surgeries at Kellogg Eye Center require a second surgery.
- Average number per surgeon: 31 cases (Range: 7 – 74)
- Average reoperation rate within 6 months: 0.007 (Range: 0.000 – 0.027)

Ectropion/Entropion: Improved lid position at 3 months



- Another type of oculoplastic eye surgery aims to repair lids that are turned outwards (ectropion) or lids that are turned inwards (entropion).
- These surgeries are highly successful at Kellogg Eye Center.
